My job involves taking mammograms in mobile units, assisting with interventional breast procedures, working in assessment clinics and reading screening mammograms. All these activities involve repetitive bending positions for long periods of time. I am also the departmental key trainer for moving and handling.

How did you find out about The Bambach Saddle Seat?

I found out about the Bambach seats when doing my annual update for key trainer in moving and handling. I was shown one of the seats and shown how to use it.

What made you try the Bambach?

I found it very comfortable and arranged to borrow it for a week in the department so colleagues could try it out.

Has using the Bambach addressed the problems you wanted to overcome?

I realized that the Bambach greatly reduced bending and twisting when positioning women for a mammogram taking a lot of strain off the back and knees.

Comments

Since then we have 5 Bambach's in the department which are used for a variety of activities. We also have 1 on each mobile unit which greatly reduces the prolonged repetitive bending.
